Seafrigo Group continues its development in the port area of Le Havre in partnership with HAROPA PORT | Le Havre



HAROPA: Seafrigo Group is world specialist in temperature-controlled food logistics.

Seafrigo Group pursues its development and inaugurates a new 60,000m² (650,000 sq.ft.) ambient temperature logistics platform in Le Havre, in the port area and in the immediate vicinity of their PLS flagship (Pare Logistique Seafrigo).

The two new buildings, 30,000 m² each, owned by AG Real Estate and operated by Seafrigo for a fixed 12-year period, will be operating at full capacity by the end of the year and will accommodate logistics flows for large retailers and manufacturers in the food industry.

This new complex is designed as a true multimodal hub that will enable the company to strengthen its CSR strategy: the buildings will soon be connected to the railway network and a quay will be created to boost river traffic and encourage modal transfer to the ports of Paris.

Govt sets up committee for determination of RoDTEP rates for Exports from SEZs, EOUs

NEW DELHI: The Government has constituted a committee for the determination of RoDTEP rates for exports from special economic zones (SEZs) and export-oriented units (EOUs), as these sectors were left out in the earlier exercise, according to the DGFT.

The Government in August announced the rates of

tax refunds under the export promotion scheme RoDTEP for 8,555 products, such as marine goods, yarn and dairy items. It has set aside Rs 12,454 crore for refunds under the Remission of Duties and Taxes on Exported Products (RoDTEP) scheme for the current fiscal.

Commerce Ministry looks to cut Imports of 100+ 'priority' items

NEW DELHI: India is keen to lower imports of 102 products, including computers, urea, cotton, lentils, cameras, tractor parts and machinery. These have been on the rise.

The Commerce and Industry Ministry has identified these 'priority products' and asked at least 15 other Ministries to explore ways to enhance domestic manufacturing capacity to reduce imports.

The products, identified on HS codes at 8-digit (tariff lines), have been shared with the respective ministries, such as textiles, steel, oil and natural gas, fertiliser, and IT and electronics. "Imports of many products with high domestic production potential have increased. This is an area of concern," said an official aware of developments.

As per the analysis, items which have an average import value of \$500 million for March-August (short run) and \$1 billion per year across three years (FY19-FY21) and 10 years (FY12-FY21), have been selected. The cumulative share of these items in total imports in March-August 2021 is 57.6%.

Maximum number of products, 18, have been identified for the Department of Chemicals and Petrochemicals, 14 each for the industry department and ministry of electronics and IT, and 10 each for the heavy industries and mines ministries.

**Trade Advisory on "Unauthorised Operators dealing/ handling
Import Cargoes in violation of HCCAR 2009"**

 CFSAI/Trade Advisory/ 60/2021-22 Dtd. 28th October 2021

WHEREAS Container Freight Stations Association of India (CFSAI), the apex Association of CFS Operators closely coordinates amongst its Members and the members of the trade to ensure that export import Containerized trade routed through the CFSs is handled in most efficient, safe and secured manner by following best trade practices. Further CFSAI engages and interacts with Customs/CBIC & other Governmental & trade bodies to facilitate and ensure strict compliance of Customs Act and the Rules and regulations made thereunder including the HCCAR 2009 and also various addendums supplements and Advisories issued from time to time by the Regulating authority.

WHEREAS HCCAR 2009 and guidelines thereof explicitly state that CFSs are to deal only with Authorised and Registered entities & not with any "Unauthorised Operators dealing / handling of import Cargo in violation to HCCAR 2009"

WHEREAS basis the above, JNCH had reiterated the above stand and cautioned the Importers & exporters vide Advisory F No.SS-Gen65/18-19

CCSP Cell dated 15th March 2019 that "under no circumstances, entities those who are not authorised representative of the Importers & exporters shall be allowed to handle /deal with imported or exported goods in any manner

WHEREAS recently few instances have come to the knowledge of the association that some unscrupulous & unauthorised entities are engaging in malpractice by approaching CFSs / Shipping Lines on behalf of Importers and soliciting CCSP services. One of the modus operandi adopted by such unauthorised entities may be that they possibly pose as authorised representatives of Importers. Further such entities may possibly be getting into the act of creating fraudulent documentation such as a "Letter of authority" from Importer and subsequently creating inflated Invoices which may not be in sync with the CFS market rates & this possibility cannot be ruled out. Given the above, it is possible that the actual Importer, not being aware of the ground reality is paying such exorbitant charges, whereas in actually the inflated Billed amount is being syphoned away by

these unauthorised persons.

In view of aforesaid, vide this Trade Advisory, CFSAI on behalf of its member CFSs seeks to caution the trade about the presence of such unauthorised entities and appeals to the Importers and other members of the export import Logistics chain to exercise utmost caution as dealing with unauthorised persons / entities is not only illegal but it would be solely at their risk and cost. Also the last para of the advisory issued by the regulators clearly states "All cases of violation of these guidelines would be dealt with in terms of HCCAR 2009 and other rules/instructions on the subject".

Going forward, as a further safeguard and in endeavour to eradicate such alleged malpractices, Importers are requested to use only Customs Licensed and registered Custom Brokers and also deal with the concerned CFS either through the authorised Customs Brokers or directly. It would be appropriate if an authentic "Letter of Authority" from companies are obtained from the registered e-mail id of the said companies for every Import shipment at JNPT.

In the first seven months of the fiscal, imports rose 78.7% on-year to \$331.29 billion.

"We will hold consultations with industry to explore ways of increasing the manufacturing capacity here and reduce their imports," the official added.

SEZs and EOUs were kept out of the scheme in the list notified in August. The industry was demanding to include them in the scheme.

The Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) in a trade notice has said, "The government has constituted a committee for determination of RoDTEP rates for AA (advance authorisation)/ EOU/

SEZ exports; and to give supplementary report/recommendations on issues relating to errors or anomalies, with respect to the RoDTEP schedule of rates notified." It said members of trade and industry may submit their representations through the export promotion councils, industry associations, to the RoDTEP committee directly.

Under the RoDTEP, various central and state duties, taxes, and levies imposed on input products, among others, will be refunded to exporters. The three-member committee is chaired by former secretary G K Pillai, former CBEC member Y G Parande and former customs member Gautam Ray.

It will submit its report within eight months.

India exports 2.76 lakh tonnes of sugar in last 40 days: AISTA

NEW DELHI: Sugar mills have exported 2.76 lakh tonnes of sugar in the last 40 days of the current marketing year with maximum shipments to the UAE, trade body AISTA said on Wednesday.

Over 1.44 lakh tonnes of sugar is under loading, All India Sugar Trade Association (AISTA) said in a statement.

Mills have contracted to export 18 lakh tonnes of sugar without government subsidy so far in the 2021-22 marketing year, it added.

According to AISTA, mills have exported a total of 2,76,676 tonnes of sugar from October 1 to November 9, 2021.

Of the total exports undertaken so far, maximum export has been to the UAE at 1.08 lakh tonnes, followed by Bangladesh at 52,330 tonnes, Somalia at Rs 24,960 tonnes and Iran at Rs 22,646 tonnes.

"Due to delay in start of the mills, the raw sugar exports are slow in spite of contracting 18 lakh tonnes of sugar," AISTA said.

The exports are taking place mostly from sugar mills of Maharashtra and Karnataka. Export of 18,290 tonnes of sugar to Sri Lanka took place despite the country facing foreign exchange difficulties, the trade body said.

During the 2020-21 marketing year, India had exported a record 72.3 lakh tonnes of the sweetener. The maximum shipments were undertaken with the help of government subsidy.

Biden rolls out multibillion-dollar plan to upgrade aging U.S. ports after passage of infrastructure bill

WASHINGTON: The Biden administration outlined several initiatives recently aimed at addressing immediate supply chain challenges and other disruptions affecting global commerce.

Several senior administration officials, said the administration will begin work within the next 60 days with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers on \$4 billion worth of construction work at coastal ports, inland waterways as well as other corps-eligible facilities.

The plan will also identify and prioritize \$3.4 billion in upgrades to

obsolete inspection facilities that will make international trade more efficient through the northern and southern borders, a senior administration official said.

"This is a long-overdue infrastructure improvement and it has clearly been a bottleneck in the past," the person added.

The officials said the administration plans to standardize data-sharing requirements for shipping lines, terminal operators, railroads, truckers, warehouses and cargo owners.

"There is not a lot of data-

sharing among the private sector and participants in the goods movement chain," the official said, adding that the lack of data exchange causes delays and inefficiencies as cargo moves from one part of the supply chain to another.

The U.S. Digital Service is working with the Federal Maritime Commission and the joint program office at the Department of Transportation to build a data framework that will help move goods more efficiently, the senior Biden administration official said.

India's GDP growth to be fastest in the World : Finance Ministry

NEW DELHI: India is on track to become the fastest growing economy in the world and attract big-ticket global investments on the back of a strong recovery in macro and micro growth indicators, the Finance Ministry has said in a report.

"Armed with necessary macro

and micro growth drivers, the stage is set for India's investment cycle to kick-start and catalyse its recovery towards becoming the fastest growing economy in the world," the ministry said in the monthly economic report for October.

The Ministry said it expects

further stimulation in demand, improved restoration of supply chains, narrowing of demand-supply mismatches, and greater employment generation amid a strong ongoing recovery powered by structural reforms, widespread vaccination, and a fall in new pandemic cases.

ICS & IMO meet with Green Climate Fund to discuss the provision of up to \$1.5 million to accelerate zero carbon R&D fund



International Chamber of Shipping
Shaping the Future of Shipping

LONDON: Meeting in the margins of the Shaping the Future of Shipping conference in Glasgow, the Deputy Executive Director of the Green Climate Fund, the Secretary General of the International Maritime Organization, and the Secretary General of the International Chamber of Shipping met to discuss funding options for the proposed 'IMO Maritime Research Fund' (IMRF).

A key aim with the meeting was to develop potential solutions to ensure that developing economies from Latin America, the Caribbean, Africa, Eastern Europe, Central Asia, and the Pacific can access technology and funding for zero carbon ships and the required infrastructure.

One solution to be discussed further in the coming weeks is the potential availability of up to USD 1.5 million from the GCF Project Preparation Facility

(PFF) to fast track the creation of the IMRF; a USD 5 billion research and development fund to accelerate research and development into zero emission technologies to be used by shipping.

The International Maritime Organization (IMO) are due to review a proposal to form a USD 5 billion R&D programme at its next Marine Environment Protection Committee to be held right after COP26. The USD 5 billion fund would be overseen by IMO and financed through a mandated R&D contribution by ship owners of USD 2 per tonne of marine fuel consumed. The shipping industry wants the fund in place by 2023.

Guy Platten, Secretary General of the International Chamber of Shipping, commented: "In 2019, our industry put forward a proposal to create a USD 5 billion innovation fund to kick start the R&D needed to deploy the technologies required to deliver a zero emissions future. This would not add a penny in taxes and would provide a fund

which could be leveraged by industry and governments. This is a no brainer, something that all governments can jump at to send a clear message that the world is serious about the energy transition and climate goals.

"I am grateful for the leadership of the Green Climate Fund and their attention given to the initiatives highlighted here at COP26, as well as their interest in supporting the IMO Maritime Research Fund, particularly for developing countries. All the preparation has been done to ensure we can hit the ground running as soon as the IMRF proposal is approved. With the GCF funds we would also have the start-up funds in place. The only thing that can stop us now are Member States willingness to live up to the commitments they are making here in Glasgow."

The meeting also discussed the possibility of GCF providing additional support to developing economies to attract match funding, which could significantly increase the levels of R&D available to developing economies.

Port of Antwerp, Port of Zeebrugge and Chile join forces to foster hydrogen production



Port of Antwerp

ANTWERP: The Belgian ports and Chile sign Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) at COP26 in Glasgow and will

intensively collaborate to make green hydrogen flows between the continents a reality.

On November 4th, Port of Antwerp, Port of Zeebrugge and the Chilean Ministry of Energy signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) in which they commit to working together to make green hydrogen flows between Chile and Western Europe a reality. This cooperation will eliminate the last barriers and gaps in the run-up to the effective start-up of green production, the set-up of the logistics chain between the continents and the logistics in the Belgian seaports and their hinterland.

In the MoU, that was signed on Energy Day during the COP26 in Glasgow, the different parties express their interest in collaborating on the important strategic issue of setting up a corridor between their countries to ship green hydrogen or derivatives, produced in Chile and received at the Belgian Ports, for further distribution to meet expected demand in Europe. The signing of the MoU took place after a debate on hydrogen import between Sébastien Arbola (Executive Vice President, ENGIE), Tom Hautekiet (CEO, Port of Zeebrugge), Juan Carlos Jobet (Chilean Minister of Energy) and Tine Van der Straeten (Belgian Minister of Energy), and moderated by Noam Boussidan (Lead Energy, World Economic Forum).

Two major European energy hubs

Port of Antwerp, Europe's largest port in terms of size and integrated chemical cluster activities, and Port of Zeebrugge, Belgium's most important LNG hub and offshore wind power plant, play an important role as fossil energy hubs for Western Europe. They receive, store and dispatch important volumes of energy to power, heat, chemistry and transportation off-takers. Port of Antwerp and Port of Zeebrugge intend to become part of the Belgian and European climate solution by acting as early mover renewable energy hubs, making use of their infrastructures, know-how and network to import and deploy important volumes of hydrogen to the European hinterland

Both ports are convinced that the future Western European energy system will need to focus on domestic wind and solar energy, as well as imported volumes of renewable hydrogen. They believe that hydrogen carriers will be the adequate form of energy to allow the transition in sectors such as marine shipping, chemistry, fuel and steam production. Hence their role as a key actor in the Hydrogen Import Coalition, whose goal is to combine public and industrial partners to gain all the system insights needed to take the right actions.

Jacques Vandermeiren, CEO Port of Antwerp: "When we look back at the impact of COP26, I sincerely hope we will call it 'the climate action summit'. The summit where promises were made and kept. That's the only way how we will be able to tackle this challenge, by saying what we do and doing what we say. At Port of Antwerp, we will continue to push forward our ambitions to make sure our entire fleet, eco-friendly and to further develop as a multi fuel port, offering the alternative fuels that sustainable shipping requires."

Tom Hautekiet, CEO Port of Zeebrugge, says: "We are proud to know that Chile, the most significant potential exporter of green molecules, wants to cooperate with the ports of Antwerp and Zeebrugge. This opportunity will allow us to realize our shared ambition of importing hydrogen to Europe together. The fact that they consider Zeebrugge to be a suitable import port confirms our position as an important energy hub. Moreover, our close cooperation will herald a new chapter for the energy transition in and of Europe."

Chile's ambitious energy plan

Chile, through its national Green Hydrogen Strategy, has set very ambitious targets in order to become a carbon-neutral country by 2050 and utilize the high-quality and abundant renewable energy resources available to it.



The country aims to be producing the cheapest green hydrogen by 2030 and become one of the top 3 exporters of green hydrogen by 2040. The Chilean Ministry of Energy, which is leading the green hydrogen strategic policy, is required to engage with overseas parties to cooperate on the issue of setting up international supply chains of green hydrogen from Chile. The signing of this MoU is a further step towards fulfilling their sustainability commitments.

Juan Carlos Jobet, Minister of Energy in Chile: "This is excellent news to continue consolidating Chile's leadership in the development of this new industry. Our potential in clean energy will allow us to be the cheapest producers of green hydrogen in the world, with which we will be able to satisfy our demand, but also help other countries to advance with their climate goals"

A decisive cooperation for the future of green hydrogen

Port of Antwerp, Port of Zeebrugge and the Ministry of Chile will collaborate on a regular basis in order to exchange knowledge, experiences and other information to further explore the possibilities of the cooperation. This latter is particularly important to eliminate the challenges in the run-up to the effective start-up of green production in Chile, the set-up of the logistics chain between our continents and the logistics in the Flemish seaports and their hinterland.

Annick De Ridder, Alderwoman of Antwerp, responsible for the port: Together with the industry, ports play an important role in finding solutions for our climate. For this reason the agreement between the ports of Antwerp and Zeebrugge is an important milestone in the fight against climate change, making sustainable energy flows more accessible in Europe. As the port of Antwerp we are delighted with this agreement, which further consolidates our position as a sustainable energy hub in Europe.

Dirk De Fauw, Mayor of Brugge: "The signing of the 'letter of intent' will certainly open new doors for the ports of Zeebrugge and Antwerp. The green hydrogen produced in Chile in the coming years will primarily be used for domestic consumption, but there are concrete plans to export green hydrogen to other parts of the world as well. Zeebrugge would thereby become the hub for the supply of Green Hydrogen in Western Europe. This element of cooperation was already extensively discussed during the merger negotiations with the port of Antwerp Bruges as a real green energy hub of the future."
