CIRCULAR

Sub: Implementaion of RFID-enabled access control system (e-Drishti) in DPA-reg

In continuation of earlier circulars on the subject and inorder to achieve efficiency in RFID-enabled access control system (e-Drishti) at varies gates, the following decisions have been taken in consultation with the stakeholders (CHA) in the meeting held on 17/08/2022.

1. Bundar area, CJ-13 & CJ-15 In and Out Gates will be operationalized for RFID-based access control system i.e. e-Drishti from 23rd August 2022 at 10:00 AM.
2. Lane number 5 of West Gate-1 will be closed and instead the outstation vehicle's entry will be allowed from West Gate-1 In lane-1 & 2 from 23rd August 2022 at 10:00 AM.
3. The stakeholders to adhere with the RFID-enabled access control system (e-Drishti) procedure strictly ensuring valid permits for the vehicles to enter the port premises.
 - a. The vehicles which will enter without valid permit will be charged a double-entry permit value as a penalty from 23rd August 2022.
 - b. Since the drivers of the vehicles entering into the port premises are unable to inform the name of the concerned CHA before entering the port premises, the concerned CHA/Port users to make sure that driver/helper of the vehicle should be informed of the name of the CHA under whose account the vehicle is entering into the port premises to the authorized persons of DPA, in case of vehicles entering without valid permits.
4. As per the directive of SHO Kandla Police station, the police NOC is a mandatory document that needs to be uploaded and ensure the validity of obtaining RFID Card.
5. Renewal of the RFID card, valid Police NOC has to be uploaded.
6. Therefore, driver/helper should ensure to get the Police verification certificate from the concerned Police stations and upload the NOC document in the e-Drishti portal www.sanya.ai/edrishti.on or before 17th Sept 2022.
7. Deviation, if any for compliance to the RFID-enabled access control system in particular vehicles entering into Port area without valid permits, will be viewed seriously and further action as deemed fit will be taken against the concerned CHA after 23rd August 2022 without any further notice/intimation.
