It may be noted that the deputationist officer is deemed to have been relieved on the date of expiry of the deputation period unless the competent authority has with requisite approval, extended the period of deputation in writing, prior to the date of expiry of deputation tenure. In the event of the officer overstaying for any reason whatsoever, he is liable for disciplinary action and other adverse civil/ service consequences which would include the period of overstay not being counted for service for the purpose of pension and that any increment due during the period overstayed being deferred with cumulative effect, till the date on which the officer rejoins in his parent cadre. In such an event, proceedings for deemed resignation from the service would also be initiated.


