
**Subject: Proposal for writing off relaxation count availed by importers in PQIS-reg.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to DPPQ&S letter No. 99-113/2019-PQD (2) dated 04.06.2024 on subject cited above and to convey the approval of competent authority in DA&FW on the following.

- i. In processing the cases of relaxation, the relaxation counts availed by the individual importers prior to 18th April, 2022 i.e. the launching of PQMS may not be considered. Only relaxation granted on or after the launch of PQMS w.e.f. 18th April, 2022 will be taken into account. The DPPQ&S to ensure proper data retrieval in the PQMS on the relaxation cases w.e.f. 18th April, 2022.
- ii. The DPPQ&S to further analyse the data on relaxation and submit a proposal to the Ministry to review the relaxation procedure based on the commodities within 7 days times.
