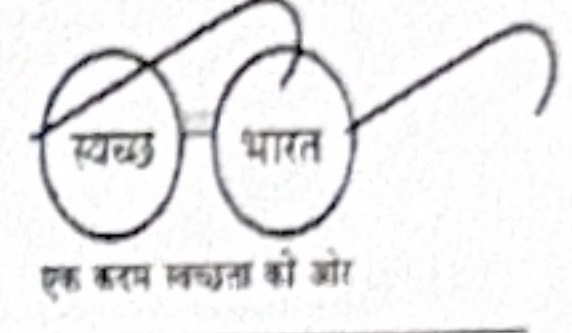

TRADE NOTICE

Subject: Mandatory Safety Training Programme for Dock Workers Engaged Through Labour Contractors under Stevedores/CHA/Vessel Agents – Reg.

In pursuance of the Port's ongoing accident prevention initiatives and in compliance with the provisions of the Dock Workers (Safety, Health and Welfare) Regulations, 1990, Deendayal Port Authority (DPA) has organized a Mandatory Safety Training Programme for dock workers/labours engaged through labour contractors under Stevedores, CHA and Vessel Agents with effect from 03 June 2026.

The objective of the programme is to enhance safety awareness among dock workers, promote safe working practices, prevent accidents and occupational injuries, and ensure compliance with statutory safety requirements during cargo handling and allied port operations.

All Stevedores, CHA and Vessel Agents are hereby advised to coordinate with their respective labour contractors and ensure nomination of workers for participation in the training programme. The programme shall be applicable to all dock workers/labours engaged through labour contractors under Stevedores, CHA and Vessel Agents and deployed in cargo handling and allied port operations within DPA limits.

Each agency shall nominate a minimum of five (05) workers per batch, subject to an overall batch capacity of 50 participants per batch. Additional workers may be nominated in subsequent batches until all eligible workers are covered under the programme.

Risk-Based Categorization of Workers for Mandatory Safety Training :

Risk Category	Cargo / Operation Type	Workers Covered	Target Date for Completion of Training
Category-I (High Risk)	Steel Cargo, Sulphur, Coal, Timber, Pine Logs and Similar Cargo Operations	All Dock Workers/Labours engaged through labour contractors and deployed in cargo handling operations	On or before 30.06.2026
Category-II (Medium Risk)	Bagged Cargo Vessels and Other Bulk Cargo Vessel Operations	All Dock Workers/Labours engaged through labour contractors and deployed in cargo handling operations	On or before 31.07.2026

All Stevedores, CHA and Vessel Agents shall ensure that all dock workers/labours engaged through labour contractors in the respective cargo operations undergo the Mandatory Safety Training Programme within the stipulated target dates.

No untrained worker shall be deployed in the concerned cargo operations after the prescribed target date. It is further informed that the mandatory safety training requirement shall be linked with the Port Entry Pass system. Workers who have not successfully completed the prescribed safety training programme may not be considered eligible for issuance, renewal or continuation of Port Entry Passes after the prescribed target date, as decided by the Port Authority from time to time.

The training programme shall be conducted for a full day and attendance of the nominated workers shall be mandatory. Tea, refreshments and lunch shall be provided to all participants.

Training Certificates shall be issued to participants upon successful completion of the training programme. The certificate shall serve as documentary evidence of compliance with the mandatory safety training requirement prescribed by the Port Authority.

The Schedule for the First Week of June 2026 is enclosed herewith for information and necessary compliance. All concerned Stevedores, CHA and Vessel Agents are requested to ensure participation of the nominated workers as per the allotted batch and date without fail.

The cooperation of all stakeholders is solicited in strengthening the safety culture within the Port and achieving the common objective of safe, efficient and accident-free port operations.

THIS TRADE NOTICE SHALL BE TREATED AS MOST URGENT.

Note:

1. The present training programme is applicable only to Dock Workers/Labours engaged through labour contractors under Stevedores, CHA and Vessel Agents.
2. Supervisors, Foremen, Clerical Staff and other managerial/supervisory personnel are excluded from the present training schedule. However, they may participate in the regular safety training programmes conducted by DPA as per the monthly training schedule circulated from time to time.
3. Stevedores, CHA and Vessel Agents shall ensure timely nomination and participation of workers in accordance with the above categorization and target dates.
4. Training Certificates shall be issued only upon successful completion of the training programme and shall be considered for compliance verification wherever required by the Port Authority.
5. Non-compliance with the provisions of this Trade Notice shall be viewed seriously and may attract appropriate action as deemed fit by the Port Authority.
