# MINUTES OF MEETING OF DOCK SAFETY COMMITTEE HELD ON 31.03.2022 AT 15.30 HRS. IN THE BOARD ROOM, A.O. BUILDING, GANDHIDHAM.

Issues raised Action Sr. **Action By** No. 01 Illumination 14 berth high mast towers: Electrical Level M/s. Vishal Electricals, Gazidabad has been commenced work. The above berth is under finalisation to operate on PPP mode. There is no provision to charge the above new installations. Hence, the above towers were relocated. 34 & 5 hector high mast towers: 5 hector high mast work is going to be complete with the 14 berth High mast towers. Accordingly, the estimate & DTP of High mast towers of 34 & 5 Hector (bundar basin area) is under midifing stage duly discarding 5 hector part. The same will send to finance in a week period. **Procurement of 1500 Led fittings:** Material received on 24/03/22. Fitting of LED lights also started. 16 berth High mast towers: Pre-bid queries are under circulation for signature of committee members. Dy. Commandant CISF told that level of illumination is low at outside roads of port. He suggested that, CISF team is ready to take an inspection round along with electrical team during night hours for improvement in illumination. Dy. Chairman instructed to SE (E ) to review and rectify the issue of illumination on outside road (Road lights) from west gate-1 to west gate-2 and further to berth no.13 gate on top priority. Outside Road from West Gate-2 to West Gate-3: 02 Roads, Civil drainages RCC road work completed & and other GAD welfare 40 hectare Road: facilities Preparation of Tender is under progress. **Drainage:** It is communicated by civil department that regular cleaning is being carried out of all drainage inside the port. New culverts prepared at strategic locations to avoid water logging. Outside drainage preparation work is under progress. Dy. Chairman instructed to Dy. CE that Drainage alongside of outside roads of port is to be connected with main drainage so that issue of water logging and further

It was discussed during the meeting that charges for the medical examination of the workers is seems higher and the same needs to be reviewed.  Dy. Chairman instructed to FA&CAO and Traffic Manager for checking the feasibility of collecting charges for the medical examination of workers as per tonnage basis of cargo from stevedores/CHA as was done in the case of training centre for safety and productivity re-engineering.  A note has been initiated on the subject and forwarded to FA&CAO as directed by the Dy. Chairman. Intern they asked to furnish the minutes of dock safety committee held on 31/12/2021 and accordingly the minutes is furnished to FA&CAO.  FA & CAO suggested that the charges collected for the training centre for safety and productivity reengineering can be reviewed and balance amount can be utilized for the payment of the charges against the medical examination of the workers.  Dy. Chairman instructed to FA&CAO and Traffic Manager for review and expedite the matter on priority.  The work has been completed in consultation with FCSO. Firefighting line is in operational condition. (Comments of Civil Department)  Dy. Chairman instructed to CME department for expedite the tender of OISD 156 compliance for firefighting system on top priority. Also existing firefighting system shall be maintained in operable condition to mitigate the emergency. Total 66 bidders in traffic warden's bid and 40 bidders in safety supervisor's bid have participated. Currently technical evaluation is under progress for the same.  Dy. The current circle size is small and roads are broader which is creating confusion to drivers who comes from west gate-1 to west gate 3.  Dy. Union representatives addressed that the port shall develop mechanism to ensure that all workers working inside the port are covered under workman compensation/insurance policy. This will help to next kin of victim who suffered from injury/ casualty in case of accident.  Dy.
