#### What is ATA Carnet?

#### Why Invented?



It eliminates complicated Customs declarations to be made, or deposits, guarantees or bonds to be lodged at borders and Customs points

Duty/tax free admission of goods up to one year
















#### **ATA Carnet**





- Joint initiative by World ATA Carnet Council (WATAC), Paris in association with World Customs Organization (WCO)
- accepted in 78 countries
- each member nation has an apex organization, as National Issuing & Guaranteeing Association (NIGA)

## ATA CARNET IN INDIA

#### Part of the System since August 1990



- > Operationalized by Notification 157/90 Customs, as amended.
- Initially in India, ATA System dealt with only those goods covered under the Government Approved Exhibitions/Fairs or Similar Events.
- ➤ However, with effect from 5<sup>th</sup> October 2016, the Government vide Notification No. 58/2016-Cus extended the scope of ATA Carnet to cover Private Exhibitions/Fairs or Similar Events.
- ➤ The scope of system has been further expanded vide CBIC Notification No. 04/2018 dated 18<sup>th</sup> January 2018 to cover professional equipment meant for TV/film shoot, press/media coverage, sporting events, testing & calibration etc.





# The ATA Carnet System What are its practical advantages?



#### **Advantages of ATA Carnet System**



➤ Valid for One year; Allows for multiple entries/exits into foreign countries within its one-year validity

➤ Single document for all customs transactions - replaces the national customs declaration at each entry/exit points



#### **Advantages of ATA Carnet System**

eliminates posting financial guarantee in foreign country



- no cash deposit of duties/taxes
- capital is not locked in foreign customs custody
- ➤ reduces risk associated with carrying large sums of foreign currencies

- Any Company or An Individual
- Start-Ups/SMEs
- Customs House Agents or Freight Forwarding Companies

- **OCCUPATION** Complete invoice of the goods to be carried
- **Ø**Security Deposit in the form of bank guarantee or bank draft for the applicable duty in the country of destination plus further 10%
- **Ø**Processing fees
- **Ø**Application Form & Undertaking

#### UN TIR – Multimodal Customs Transit System



- India acceded to TIR Convention in June 2017 the Customs Convention on International Transport of Goods under cover of TIR Carnets.
- Facilitates seamless movement of goods between member countries
   Supported by: The United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE), TIR Convention
   Bodies
- Managed by: International Road Transport Union (IRU), Geneva

Operationalised by the Customs Circular No. 48/2018 -Customs dated 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2018.

## Who can Apply for UN TIR Carnet?

- **?** AEO operators are eligible.
- Any Company/Entity or Customs House Agents/Freight Forwarders which has business activities for at least 3 years (No previous record of serious criminal offences linked to the economic activity of the business in the past) Subject to CBIC approval.
- Page 2 Pag
- Admission Guarantee in the form of a Cash Deposit or a Bank Guarantee
- Processing Fee
- Signed the Declaration of Engagement
